The key focus is to avoid rough-sleeping. As this is a crisis placement, the service will be on a one night only basis and only one offer of accommodation will be made.</p> <p>Hours of operation: 10 am - 4 pm Monday – Friday 12 pm - 4 pm Saturday & Sunday 4.30 pm to 9pm seven days a week.</p>
